2. INTENDED USE

ERGO XR2 chair provides different height and lateral adjustments to take an X-ray of a patient in a sitting position. It is used to support a seated patient during a medical examination or short procedure. It is intended to be operated by healthcare professionals in a medical environment including hospitals, clinics, and doctor's offices.






5. LABEL

Symbol identification






6. OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Chair functions


<u>^</u>	WARNING. Always make sure you have enough clearance around the chair before activating the various movements to avoid collisions with the surroundings and people.
	WARNING. Always lock wheels before the patient is placed on chair.
	WARNING. Always lower the chair to the lowest position before the patient sits in the chair.
	WARNING. The patient should only sit and stand from the front of the chair.
	WARNING. Do not leave patient unattended.
	WARNING. Once arm and backrest are locked in upward position, make sure they are securely locked.
	WARNING. Ensure that lateral movement of the seat is locked after use and before patient sits in the chair.


6.2 Retractable armrests and backrest

\triangle	WARNING. Never exceed safe working load of 75lb or 34kg on armrest.
	WARNING. Do not sit on backrest.

6.3 Central lock

The central locking mechanism is controlled with the pedals located at the base, in the center of the chair. Engage pedal foot pedal in one of the 2 positions:

- Red: 3 wheels out of 5 are locked;
- Green: all 5 wheels unlocked.



7. CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

\wedge	WARNING. Always clean chair between patient to avoid contamination.
	WARNING. Clean chair immediately after spillage of bodily or other fluids.
$\overline{\wedge}$	WARNING. Protect cushion cover from sharp and rough objects to avoid damaging it.
<u>^</u>	WARNING. Always inspect cushions to ensure its integrity. A damaged cushion can absorb contaminated liquids. In case of tear or wear, contact Umano Medical to immediately replace the damaged cushion.
	WARNING. Do not pressure wash or steam clean.
$\overline{\wedge}$	WARNING. It is the user's responsibility to wear adequate protective equipment to avoid contamination from bodily fluids or other debris on the chair.
\wedge	WARNING. Any damage to the chair caused by the use of a product other than those mentioned in this section or at a different concentration is not covered by the warranty.
<u> </u>	WARNING. Do not use cleaning products containing other products or in concentration other than those specified in this section.
	WARNING. Do not use abrasive cleaning products.

7.1 Recommended cleaning products

- Disinfectant containing sodium hypochlorite (bleaching product) in a <u>maximum concentration</u> of 0.5%. Always rinse with clean water and dry with a clean cloth.
- Disinfectant containing hydrogen peroxide diluted in a <u>maximum concentration of 0.5%</u>. Always rinse with clean water and dry with a clean cloth.
- Disinfectant containing alcohol diluted in a <u>maximum concentration of 22%</u>. Always rinse with clean water and dry with a clean cloth.
- It is recommended to use "ready-to-use" cleaning products.

Notes:

- Always test the cleaning product in an inconspicuous place to check the effect of this product on the cleaned surface.
- Always follow manufacturer's cleaning products instructions.
- Clean spills as soon as possible to prevent absorption and from becoming a permanent stain.

9. WARRANTY

The Umano Medical chairs are designed for a 10-year service life under normal use, conditions, and with periodic maintenance as recommended in Maintenance Manual.

Shipment receipt

The purchaser should examine the shipment upon receipt. Umano Medical must be notified by the purchaser within 30 days of invoice of any short shipment, or any order-mistake. Apparent shipment damage must be noted on delivery receipt and notified immediately to Umano Medical. A claim in the amount of replacement cost will be initiated with the carrier for the damages incurred. If any damage is found, the purchaser must notify Umano Medical within 15 days of shipment receipt.

Product return

Merchandise cannot be returned without approval from Umano Medical. An authorization number will be provided which must be printed on the packaging of the returned merchandise. Modified or discontinued products are not subject to return.

Limited warranty

Umano Medical warrants to the original purchaser that the products shall be free of structural defects in material and workmanship for a determined period after date of delivery; refer to the purchase documentation for information about the available warranty time periods. Umano Medical's obligation under this warranty is expressly limited to supplying replacement parts and/or service for, or replacing, at its option, any product that is, in the sole discretion of Umano Medical, found to be defective. In addition, Umano Medical warrants for life to the original purchaser that the welds on its products will be free from structural defects. Any repair using non-authorized or non-original parts and any product alteration or modification will void this warranty.
